## The Letter Thet

### Explanation

#### Summary

**Name:** *Thet* (teyt)

**Pronunciation:** *th* as in **Th**ankyou

**Picture:** Container made of wicker or clay

**Meaning:** Basket, contain, store, clay, surround

**Numerical Value:** 6

The **ninth letter** of the Ancient Hebrew Alphabet is **Thet**, in Modern Hebrew it is called – **tet**, meaning mud or clay. *Tet* in Modern Hebrew is pronounced as a *t* – but the alphabet has another letter, *Tav*, with the same sound. Thus the Ancient Hebrew pronunciation of **th** makes more sense.

The Modern Hebrew name *tet* is spelt *Thet*, *Yod*, *Tav* but the Ancient Hebrew biblical word *Thet*, spelt *Thet*, *yod*, *Thet* means **clay**, so we can assume that the original spelling of the letter was *Thet*, *yod*, *Thet*.



# Thet

Containers were very important to the nomadic Hebrews. They were used for **storing** food and other items. **Wicker baskets** were used as nets for **catching fish**.

Different forms of the letter **Thet:**

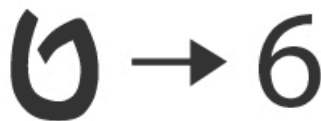

The letter remained the same in the early period between the Ancient Hebrew and the Middle Script era. The *Late Script* was the origin of the Greek letter **Theta** and also evolved into the **number 6**.

An example of a word that begins with the letter **Thet:**

**Tov** [T-ov] = Good



BET

THET

TOV = GOOD

It is used in:

Good Morning – *Boker Tov*

Good Evening – *Erev Tov*

Good Night – *Layla Tov*

## The numerical value of **Thet**

*Thet* is the 9<sup>th</sup> letter of the alphabet but the **numerical value** of the letter *Thet* is **6**. Most people know that the number 6 refers to **man, human weakness and the manifestation of sin** (flesh). This is true but the number **six** also refers to **image**.

An example of this is the *image* that Nebuchadnezzar erected which was *60 cubits by six cubits*. Idols were usually created in the image of *demons* and we on the other hand were originally created in the image of YHUH.

If we look back at the meaning of the letter *Thet*, it means **basket, contain, store, clay, surround**. We are clay vessels, formed from the dust of the earth, and our purpose is to contain Messiah and His Spirit inside of us.

When you encounter the number six, see if it is used in a negative or positive way and always take into account the context in which it is used.

### The nr 6 in the Word:

- **Man** was **created** on the **sixth day**
- **Men** are given **six days** to **work** (man's own attempt to provide) but on the seventh day you enter into His rest (trust in His provision) – physically and spiritually
- **Mankind** are given **6000** years on earth - 6000 years to restore us to His image.
- A **Hebrew slave** was allowed to **serve only 6** years but in the seventh year he must be set free
- The **land** was only to be **sown and harvested** for **6 years**
- There are **six people** mentioned in the New Testament who practiced **sorcery** – divination with the assistance of evil spirits.
- Yahusha was asked **6 times** by self-righteous people to show them a **sign** to proof He is who He says He is. This is the '**sign**' of a **wicked generation**
